



## Plaza de Abajo Neighbourhood

In medieval Pastrana, the 'Livestock Gate' was found here, an entrance in the wall that had enough space for livestock to pass through. However, this gate must have lasted a short time as there is no news or memory of it since the 17th century. There was also an oil mill and an old hospital called Moncayo in this area.

The neighbourhood of the 'Lower Square' and the adjoining blocks, with its pronounced network of particularly narrow and steep streets, make this neighbourhood the ideal place to lose yourself and feel transported back in time. It is one of the first medieval neighbourhoods of the village, and in it we find curious fountains that still conserve the supply of nearby springs. When we reach the Plaza de Abajo we see in its centre a fountain dedicated to the Spanish Navy with an anchor in its basin.
