

Burgos Palace

Monument not open to the public.

This palace was built at the beginning of the 17th century, within the walls of Pastrana before the rebuilding of the medieval wall in 1650. It was a simple construction of the noble family from which it takes its name, Burgos. Like the rest of the mansions in the neighbourhood it contains gardens and internal patios, difficult to imagine from the outside. This model for a noble house model followed the trend introduced by the design of the Saint Buenaventura School.

On its main facade we can see the imposing coat of arms of this family, crested by the helmet that indicated its nobility. In the early years of the 21st century it has been rebuilt as flats and apartments, but core elements such as the large architraved gate, the corner ashlars and the ironwork are still preserved.
